FINAL DECISION

On December 2, 2022, the Executive Director, pursuant to a delegation of authority by the Commission, and on its behalf, immediately imposed the suspension of the Respondent Devon Bone’s certification after receiving records from [REDACTED], showing that the Respondent was [REDACTED]. See M.G.L. c. 6E, § 9(a)(1) (“The [C]ommission shall immediately suspend the certification of any officer who is arrested, charged or indicted for a felony.”).

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 6E, § 9(a)(5), “[a] suspension order of the [C]ommission issued pursuant to [Section 9(a)(1)] shall continue in effect until issuance of the final decision of the [C]ommission or until revoked by the [C]ommission.” See also 555 CMR 1.08(4). The Commission has received and reviewed papers related to the Respondent’s suspension of certification at the executive session on September 7, 2023. Among other things, there is evidence showing that a [REDACTED]. Based on this, and other evidence presented to the Commission, the Commission has determined that the Respondent’s suspension should be lifted, and the Respondent shall return to the certification status possessed prior to the suspension imposed on December 2, 2022. Accordingly, the suspension of the Respondent’s certification shall no longer remain in effect, and the Executive Director shall not publish the Respondent’s name in the list of suspended officers.

This is the **final decision** of the Commission. See M.G.L. c. 6E, § 9(a)(5); 555 CMR 1.08(4); see also M.G.L. c. 6E, §§ 10(a) and (b). This concludes all pending disciplinary matters before the Commission.
