DECERTIFICATION ORDER

The Respondent Michael Eracleo has entered into a Voluntary Decertification Agreement ("Agreement") under which he has agreed to the revocation of his certification as a law enforcement officer in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the entry of his decertification in the National Decertification Index ("NDI"). See M.G.L. c. 6E, §§ 3(a), 10(b)(iii) and (v); M.G.L. c. 30A, § 10. As further conditions of the Agreement, the Respondent has waived all rights to contest, in this or any other administrative or judicial proceeding to which the Massachusetts Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission ("Commission") is or may be a party, the allegations, factual findings, conclusions of law, terms and conditions, and other provisions contained in the Agreement.

Accordingly, it is hereby <u>ORDERED</u> that, for the reasons stated in the Agreement:

- (a) The Respondent's certification is hereby revoked;
- (b) The Executive Director shall characterize this action as a "Voluntary Decertification"; and
- (c) The Executive Director shall take the necessary steps to publish the Respondent's name and decertification status in the NDI and any publicly available lists and database published by the Commission.
